# Membership Dues

Renew Your Membership at the September Meeting \$50/Person

In order to schedule this season's monthly demonstrators and programs, we need to have an accurate accounting of our membership dues.

We appreciate your continued support and ask that you take a moment now to bring a check (preferred) to our meeting in September to renew your annual dues.

#### **EXHIBITORS' GUIDELINES**

#### **Gem Membership Exhibits:**

- 1. Only members may enter work for judging.
- 2. Members must have dues paid prior to the time of judging.
- 3. All entries must be registered prior to the meeting.
- 4. All paintings must be framed or gallery-wrapped with no staples showing and all sides painted; all paintings must be dry.
- 5. Members must enter their own work and be present to win.
- 6. Any entry winning a blue or gold First Place ribbon may not be re-entered for judging again. Others may be re-entered after three (3) months.
- **7.** Members may enter **one (1) entry** each month in their selected category: Master, Advanced, Intermediate, Entry or Photography.
- 8. Master artists must enter their work into the Master's category only. Master artists include professional demonstrators and those who sell their work professionally and those who earned the level via Gem criteria.
- 9. Members earning 3 first-place entries during the same season will advance to the next higher level.

<u>Categories</u>: Once a member selects their category, they <u>remain in that category all</u> <u>season</u> unless they advance due to 3 first-place wins.

#### **Entry Level**

- Have created artwork off and on for 2 years or less
- Little to no experience with your chosen medium
- Starting artwork for the first time
- May use teacher assistance for some areas of artwork

#### Intermediate

- Somewhat comfortable with your chosen medium
- Returning to art after several years away but experienced
- Somewhat comfortable with the elements of art (see Judging Criteria in GEM handbook)

#### Advanced

- Comfortable with your chosen medium
- Have created artwork regularly for several years
- Confident use of the elements of art
- Needs little guidance/primarily works alone

#### Ribbons Awarded by the Demonstrator/Critiquing Judge:

- 1. Each category requires a minimum of three (3) entries for a ribbon to be awarded. Fewer than three entries will not generate a ribbon for that category. If there are three or more entries, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons will be awarded.
- **2.** The demonstrating judge will award ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. First place ribbons for the Master Category are Gold.

#### Ribbons awarded by the Membership-People's Choice

This ribbon is awarded to one artist during the monthly meetings. All members and non-members in attendance have one vote each and all artwork in all categories are included. If there is a tie for this award, the judge will be asked to break the tie.

**Gem Artists of the Year:** Only the Intermediate, Advanced and Master's first-place winners from the Gem competitions held between September through May can qualify. These artists will be invited to bring and display one of their winning pieces to the June meeting. The winners are selected by all members of good standing in attendance. Three ribbons will be awarded at each June meeting: one ribbon for "Artist of the year" in the Intermediate category, one ribbon in the Advanced category and one ribbon for the Masters category.


